Footpaths

Pavements

Pavements on the stretch of A30 from the Seaview bus stop at the start of the village, all the way to the entrance to Lands End.

Top of kerb and where kerb meets road surface.

This will not include overhang onto the pavements from private properties, this is the landowners responsibility.

(Cutting times below assumed third week of the month, weather depending)

March

- All 11 Grassed areas
 - Pavement weeding on A30 from Seaview Bus Stop to Lands End entrance
 - **3 main paths:**
 - Cycle Path 118/16/1 - Start of Marias Lane
 - Footpath 118/17/2 - Marias Lane to Spar
 - Footpath 118/20/2+3 - From Cove Road across The Green to Sunny Corner Lane
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April (before the 26th)

- 6 Grassed areas:
 - Escalls Chapel
 - Seaview Bus Stop and West Village Approach
 - Mayon Bus Stop
 - Sennen Cemetery
 - Sennen Churchyard
 - East Bound Village Approach
 - Strim top of Cornish hedge opposite school (leaving any obvious plants in-situ)
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May

- All 11 Grassed areas
 - All footpaths as per our Parish Map and detailed requirement schedule
 - Cemetery - Cut back growth on wall at entrance overhanging pavement
 - Cemetery - Check ivy growth on inner boundary wall and report back – potentially cut annually
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June

Footpath 118/20/2+3 - From Cove Road across The Green to Sunny Corner Lane
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October

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Note:

Stone Chair Lane - This footpath has recently had a new tarmac surface. We still need side growth trimmed back to make the most of our new wider surface. Drainage is an issue down the side of the path. The drainage ditches need trimming and the cuttings removed from the ditches (either placing on the other side of the path or removing completely). Four drainage pipes have been installed under the new footpath surface and these pipes need rodding through to ensure they are free from obstructions. Each pipe is no more than 1.5m in length and are approximately 150mm diameter.
