

Public Rights of Way (PRoW) and Grass Areas

May/June Report

- All gold/silver PRoW have been walked and assessed by councillors. (ALL)
- Queries raised by members of the public to the clerk or councillors have been reported back to the working group and forwarded to the contractor where necessary. (KH/Clerk)
- Teething issues regarding implementation of PRoW cutting schedule & works contract. Contact has been made with contractor and meeting arranged for Friday 14th. (KH/RP/AB)
- CC consulted re fenced out footpaths for potential additions to LMP. (AB)
- Electric fencing on PRoW reported to CC. (AB)
- Broken finger posts reported to CC. (AB/KS)
- Stonechair Lane (under CLUP application):
Ownership established and permissions for resurfacing obtained.
TTRO application – confirmed process with CC.
Contractor specification finalised and work scheduled in preparation for successful grant outcome. (RP)
- Grass areas around the village have been well maintained by our contractor. Areas have been assessed by councillors. (RP/AB)
- Councillors have proposed the cutting of the verge on Cove Hill, leading down from the car park entrance. As we do not permit spraying within the village, we will require this to be cut. A plan of the area has been prepared for obtaining price from grass cutting contractor. (AB)
